	102. ACADEMIC STANDARDS
1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 4.11, 4.12 Pol. 100.1	The Board recognizes the importance of developing, assessing and expanding academic standards to challenge students to achieve at their highest level possible. To this end, the Intermediate Unit shall establish rigorous academic standards in accordance with, and may expand upon, those adopted by the State Board of Education.
2. Definition Title 22 Sec. 4.3	Academic standards - shall be defined as what a student should know and be able to do at a specified grade level. For purposes of Board policy, the term academic standards shall be deemed to encompass Pennsylvania Core Standards, state academic standards and local academic standards.
3. Authority Title 22 Sec. 4.12	The Board shall ensure that all applicable Intermediate Unit programs serving students from member districts are aligned with the academic standards adopted by the State Board of Education.
	Each Intermediate Unit program providing applicable academic programs to students shall identify the academic standards to be achieved in the program, in one or more of the following content areas:
	<ol> <li>English Language Arts.</li> <li>Mathematics.</li> <li>Science and Technology – to include reading in science and technology, and writing for science and technology.</li> <li>Environment and Ecology</li> <li>Social Studies (history, geography, civics and government, economics) to include reading in history and social studies, and writing for history and social studies.</li> <li>Arts and Humanities.</li> <li>Career Education and Work.</li> <li>Health, Safety and Physical Education.</li> <li>Family and Consumer Science.</li> </ol>

4. Guidelines Title 22 Sec. 4.12	The Intermediate Unit's curriculum shall be designed to provide students with the planned instruction needed to attain established academic standards.
