202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS	
<p>1. Purpose SC 951, 964</p>	<p>The Board shall operate programs of the intermediate unit for the benefit of students residing in member school districts who are eligible for attendance.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1301, 1316 SC 1302 Title 22 Sec. 11.19</p>	<p>The Board may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with established procedures for the individual programs and when the student is referred by a participating school district.</p> <p>The Board shall require that appropriate legal documentation showing dependency or guardianship or a sworn statement of residential support be filed with the Board Secretary before an eligible nonresident student may be accepted as a student in an intermediate unit program. The Board may require a resident to submit additional reasonable information to substantiate a sworn statement.</p> <p>The Board reserves the right to verify claims of residency, dependence and guardianship and to remove from school attendance a nonresident student whose claim is invalid.</p>
<p>SC 1316. 2561</p>	<p>Tuition rates shall be determined in accordance with statute. Tuition shall be charged monthly.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines SC 1305 Title 22 Sec. 11.19, 14.104</p>	<p><u>Nonresident Children Placed in the District</u></p> <p>Any child placed in the home of a participating district resident by a court order or an arrangement with an appropriate agency shall be admitted to Intermediate Unit programs and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as a resident if the student is referred by a participating school district.</p> <p><u>Inmates of Institutions</u></p> <p>A child who is an inmate of an institution for the care or training of children located within a member district is not a legal resident of the intermediate unit by such placement; but s/he shall be admitted to the intermediate unit program, and a charge shall be made for tuition in accordance with statute and if referred by a participating school district.</p>
