## 217. GRADUATION

1. Purpose

The Board **shall** acknowledge each student's successful completion of his/her educational program appropriate to the student's abilities and needs by awarding diplomas and certificates at graduation ceremonies.

The Board of a member school district shall permit a student with a disability, whose Individualized Education Program (IEP) prescribes continued educational services, to participate in commencement ceremonies with his/her graduating class and receive a certificate of attendance, **provided that the student** has attended four (4) years of high school. **The Board of a member school district shall issue a high school diploma to each student with a disability who completes the graduation requirements established by the Board or the goals established in the student's IEP, as determined by the student's IEP team.** 

## 3. **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Executive Director or designee shall be responsible for ensuring:

1. Students **are** informed of graduation requirements they are required to complete.
