| | 224. Care of School Property |
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| 1. Purpose | The Board believes that the intermediate unit programs should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions. |
| 2. Authority | The Board charges each student in the intermediate unit programs with responsibility for the proper care of the facilities, supplies and equipment entrusted to the student's use. |
| SC 777 Pol. 218, 233 | It is the policy of the Board that students who willfully cause damage to intermediate unit property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface intermediate unit property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians shall be held accountable for the actions of their child. |
| SC 1338 | The Board may report to appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of intermediate unit property is serious or chronic in nature. In no case shall referral to juvenile authorities be made without prior notification to the student's parent. |
| 3. Delegation of Responsibility SC 109, 801 | The Executive Director or designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include rules for safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies and equipment and an established schedule of fines for lost or damages textbooks, supplies and equipment. |
