	423. TOBACCO USE
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that tobacco use during school hours and on intermediate unit property presents a health and safety hazard that can have serious consequences for the user and the nonuser and the safety of the intermediate unit.
2. Definition 18 Pa. C.S.A. 6306.1	For purposes of this policy, tobacco use shall mean all use of tobacco, including cigars, cigarettes, pipes and smokeless tobacco.
3. Authority 35 P.S. 1223.5	The Board prohibits tobacco use by professional employees in a school building and on any property, buses, vans and vehicles that are owned, leased or controlled by the intermediate unit.
	The Board may designate specific areas for tobacco use by employees on property owned, leased or controlled by the intermediate unit that is at least fifty (50) feet from school buildings, stadiums and bleachers.
4. Guidelines	The intermediate unit shall annually notify employees about the intermediate unit's tobacco use policy by publishing such in handbooks, newsletters, posted notices and other efficient methods.
	A violation of this policy shall be punishable by a civil fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).
SC 1303-A	Incidents of possession, use and sale of tobacco by any person on school property shall be reported to the Office of Safe Schools on the required form at least once each year.
