	525. DRESS AND GROOMING
1. Purpose	Employees set an example in dress and grooming for students and the community at large. Compliance with reasonable standards for dress and grooming has a positive effect upon the intermediate unit's operation and programs.
2. Authority SC 510	The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming guidelines for staff, within law, that will prevent an adverse impact on the educational program and intermediate unit operations.
3. Guidelines	When assigned to intermediate unit duties, classified employees shall be physically clean, neat, well-groomed, and dressed in a manner consistent with the needs of the job to be performed.
	Employees shall be groomed so that their hair style does not disrupt the educational process nor cause a health or safety hazard.
	Classified employees may be required to utilize safety gear or wear designated work uniforms.
4. Delegation of Responsibility	If an employee feels that an exception to this policy would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the Executive Director or designee.
