

HOMEWORK WHEN ABSENT FROM SCHOOL

If an absence is classified as “excused” or “legal”, the student will be permitted to make-up work when absent from school. Students will be afforded one (1) day for each day of excused absence for work to be completed and submitted. This applies to assignments, quizzes, tests, and/or major projects.

There will be no reduction in grade for make-up work turned in following this procedure; however, the assignment/assessment format may be modified, or altered.

If an absence is classified as “unexcused” or “illegal”, the student will not receive credit for assignments, tests, quizzes, projects, etc. For example, if a student misses a test due to an “unexcused” or “illegal” absence, the student shall receive a zero.

In addition, the teacher is not required to provide the student the opportunity to make up missed work if the absence is deemed illegal.
